Then...

Someone tests positive in my home	Everyone quarantines and awaits guidance from the VT Dept of Health
	Do: stay home, whether you have symptoms or not
	Don't: send students to school
Someone in my home is a close contact with someone who tests positive	Everyone quarantines until the individual tests negative
	Do: stay home, whether you have symptoms or not
	Don't: send students to school
Someone in my home develops COVID-like symptoms	Everyone quarantines until the individual tests negative for COVID
	Do: Call your healthcare provider and stay home until you test negative
	Don't: send students to school

If you are affected by any of the above scenarios, please reach out to your school nurse and Principal for guidance on when your student can safely return to school.

If your student tests positive for COVID, please contact your school nurse and principal immediately. We want to offer support and guidance on when your student can safely return to school.

We will always maintain confidentiality and will not share any information.

Do not send your student to school with any of the following symptoms: Fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, runny nose, lack of smell/taste, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, muscle aches, headache. If your student experiences any of these symptoms, keep them home and call the school nurse for guidance on next steps.
