Grades 3 & 4

What a wonderful 3 days! Your children are interesting, kind, and focused. This short week was filled with lots of settling in and some academic work.

We've enjoyed meeting on our big rug as a whole class. This morning we played Zoom! Transitions from one place to another can be challenging for a big class, but ours is doing great! We're practicing voices off, keeping hands at our sides, and walking with quiet feet. Students are also doing better (after only two days) at remembering to bring their folders into class each morning and place them in our folder box.

We've started our math classes. Fourth graders are practicing solving multiplication story problems. Third graders are practicing good math habits and using sorting skills. Students have all started reading books. As they finish a book, student write a summary in a reading journal. We've also been working on "ME!" projects. Students have identified something in their life that's important to them. They've told stories about it to a partner and done draft artwork to match. The next step is writing about it on the computer. This will be a "journal" entry, meaning the first draft is the final draft - a sample of their best independent work.
